Information: Dyed Parchment dates back to the Declaration of Independence. It was *Jean Michel Frank's* material of choice for cladding furniture and wall panels during the Art Deco period. Keleen's vellum skins are perfect for unusual wall panels, furniture applications, screens, lamp shades, and lighting diffusers. Due to the dying process and natural elements, tone and color will vary within each hide.
